Dear Governor Malloy:

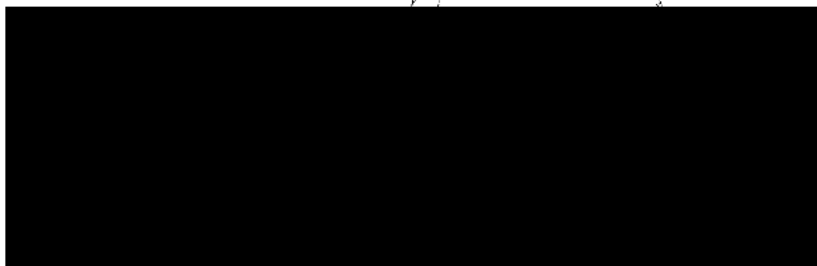

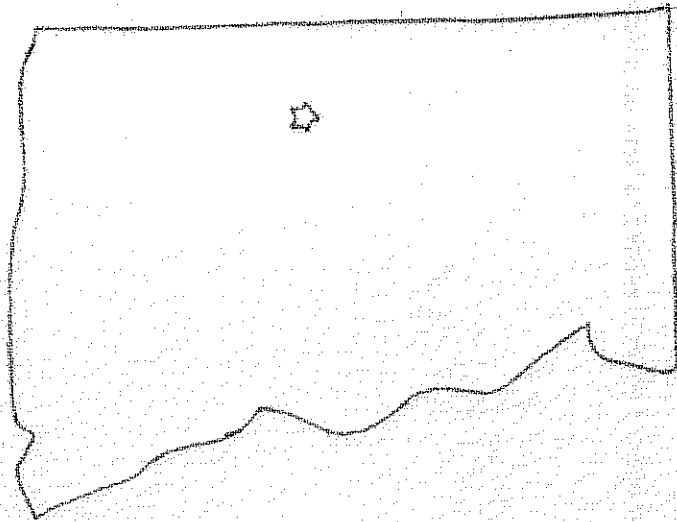
