AN ACT TO BAN THE SALE OF NONRETURNABLE BOTTLES, ETC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. No person shall sell or offer for sale or attempt to sell any nonreturnable, nondegradable or no-deposit bottle, jar, jug or container containing any kind of drink or beverage, or designed to contain any kind of drink or beverage.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1972.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To ban the sale of nonreturnable bottles etc. after July 1, 1972.
