AN ACT CONCERNING A LIMITATION OF ACTION FOR DAMAGES AGAINST A LAND SURVEYOR FOR DEFAULT OR NEGLIGENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

No civil action shall be brought for special damages against any person performing or furnishing surveys of real property, but within four years next of after completion of the surveying.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide a time limitation for actions for damages against a land surveyor.
