AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF SEWAGE DISPOSAL OR SEPTIC TANK SYSTEMS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OR SOME OTHER STATE AGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Whenever any land is subdivided into twenty-five or more lots, parcels or units for the purpose of construction the plans for the sewage disposal system or septic tank system for each such lot, parcel or unit shall be submitted to the state department of health, or its designee, for approval.

Sec. 2. No municipality shall approve any proposed subdivision until approval under section 1 of this act has been obtained from the state department of health or its designee.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To require that all subdivisions of twenty-five or more units shall have their sewage disposal or septic tank systems approved by the state department of health or its designee.
