AN ACT REQUIRING ALL MARINAS TO BE EQUIPPED WITH PUMPING 14 STATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in 16 General Assembly convened: 17

Section 1. No person, firm, corporation or association 18 shall operate any marina within this state after June 1, 1972, 19 unless such marina is equipped with sufficient marine toilet pumping stations to serve the users of such marina. 20

Sec. 2. The commissioner of health shall on or before 21 January 1, 1972 promulgate regulations specifying the number and 22 type of pumping stations to be installed in marinas. Such 23 regulations shall also specify how the waste materials removed from boats and vessels by such pumping stations are to be 24 disposed of.

Sec. 3. Any person, firm, corporation or association 25 violating the provisions of this act shall be fined one hundred 26 dollars per day during the continuation of such violation.
