AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF BATHROOM AND TOILET FACILITIES
AT MARINAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

Section 1. On or after June 1, 1972, no person, firm,
corporation or association shall operate any marina within this
state unless the same is provided with adequate bathroom and
toilet facilities sufficient to serve those persons using the
marina.

Sec. 2. The commissioner of health shall on or before
January 1, 1972 promulgate regulations specifying the number and
type of bathrooms and toilet facilities to be installed in such
marinas. Such regulations shall also specify how waste materials
arising from the installation of such facilities is to be
disposed of.

Sec. 3. Any person contravening the provisions of this act
or any regulation made thereunder shall be fined not less than
one hundred dollars for each day the violation continues.
