AN ACT CONCERNING BOATS DOCKING AT MARINAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

Section 1. No person shall use the marine toilet on any
boat or vessel which is docked at a marina within this state and
such toilets shall be sealed and rendered inoperable for so long
as such boat or vessel remains docked at such marina, provided
nothing in this section shall be deemed to prohibit the use of
any chemical toilet which has no means of direct discharge into
the water.

Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act
shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars for each
offense.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide for the sealing of marine
toilets while boats are docked at marinas.
