Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in 16 General Assembly convened: 17

AN ACT CONCERNING BOATS DOCKING AT MARINAS.

Section 1. No person shall use the marine toilet on any 18 boat or vessel which is docked at a marina within this state and 19 such toilets shall be sealed and rendered inoperable for so long 20 as such boat or vessel remains docked at such marina, provided nothing in this section shall be deemed to prohibit the use of 21 any chemical toilet which has no means of direct discharge into 22 the water.

Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act 23 shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars for each 24 offense.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide for the sealing of marine 27 toilets while boats are docked at marinas. 28
