Senate Bill No. 1670



Senate, April 22, 1971. The Committee on Public Health and Safety reported through Senator Pac of the 6th District, Chairman of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMFCSITION OF THE COUNCIL ON HOSPITALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 19-31 of the 1969 supplement to the 2 general statutes is repealed and the following is 3 substituted in lieu thereof: There is established council on hospitals to consist of the 5 commissioner of health, the commissioner of mental 6 health and [five] EIGHT other persons appointed by 7 the governor. The terms of the members of the 8 advisory committee on hospital licensing shall 9 terminate on October 1, 1969, and on or before 10 October 1, 1969, the governor shall appoint one 11 member of said council for a term of one year, one 12 member for a term of two years, one member for a 13 term of three years, one member for a term of four 14 years and one member for a term of five years from 15 said date. On or before October 1, 1970, and 16 annually thereafter, a member shall be appointed 17 for a term of five years to replace the member 18 whose term expires. At least one of such members 19 shall represent the Connecticut Hospital 20 Association and one shall regresent the chronic 21 and convalescent hospitals. ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 22 1, 1971, AND EVERY FIVE YEARS THEREAFTER, THE 23 GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THREE MEMBERS OF THE 24 GENERAL PUBLIC TO SAID COUNCIL FOR A TERM OF FIVE 25 YEARS EACH. The governor may fill any vacancy 26 occurring in the membership of said council. Said 27 council shall meet at the call of the commissioner 28 of health, upon request of any three members of 29 the council or when required in sections 19-31a to 30 19-31c, inclusive, 19-36 and 19-43. Three members 31 of the council shall constitute a quorum. The 32 commissioner of health and the commissioner of 33 mental health may each act on the council through 34 his designee.
