AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
REGIONAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE WALLINGFORD AREA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

The sum of five hundred forty-five thousand dollars is
appropriated for the year ending June 30, 1972, to the board of
trustees for regional community colleges for leasing of
facilities in the Wharton Brook Park area of southern Wallingford
and operating therein a regional community college to serve the
towns of Wallingford, Meriden, Hamden, North Haven and Cheshire.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide funds to the board of trustees
for regional community colleges for the leasing and operation of
facilities now available in the Wharton Brook Park area of
Wallingford as a regional community college to serve an area now
without an institution of higher education.
