Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

Frances Faye Vermillion, a teacher in the town of Plymouth,
shall receive credit in the teachers' retirement system for her
teaching service rendered at the American School for the Deaf
from 1936 to 1941, upon payment to the teachers' retirement
system the established rate of contributions to said system at
the time such service was rendered, with interest thereon at the
rate of five per cent per annum from the date of such services to
the date of payment.
