AN ACT PROVIDING CREDIT IN THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR 14 FRANCES FAYE VERMILLION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in 16 General Assembly convened: 17

Frances Faye Vermillion, a teacher in the town of Plymouth, 18 shall receive credit in the teachers' retirement system for her 19 teaching service rendered at the American School for the Deaf 20 from 1936 to 1941, upon payment to the teachers' retirement 21 system the established rate of contributions to said system at the time such service was rendered, with interest thereon at the 22 rate of five per cent per annum from the date of such services to 23 the date of payment.
