AN ACT CONCERNING THE DESCRIPTION OF REAL ESTATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

No description of any parcel of land which is on file with
the town clerk shall be altered unless such parcel has been
mapped by a certified surveyor, and such map has been approved by
the local planning commission or planning and zoning commission
and filed with the town clerk.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide that no description of real
estate may be altered without a map prepared by a certified
surveyor and approved by the local planning and zoning
commission.
