Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in

General Assembly convened:

Any member of the teachers' retirement system who served as

a teacher at the American School for the Deaf, prior to the time

the employees of said school became eligible to join the state

employees retirement system, may receive retirement credit under

the provisions of the teachers' retirement system for such

service, not to exceed ten years in the aggregate, on paying to

the retirement system the established rate of contributions to

said system at the time of such service, with interest thereon at

the rate of five per cent per annum from the date of such service

to the date of payment. Such payment shall be made within five

years from the date of employment or reemployment as a teacher in

the public schools or within five years from October 1, 1971,

whichever is later. No person who benefits from this section may

receive retirement income from both the state employees

retirement fund and the teachers' retirement system. 33

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To permit members of the teachers' 36  
retirement system to receive credit in the system for service 37  
with the American School for the Deaf prior to the time such 38  
school came under the state employees retirement system. 39
