



Senate, May 7, 1971. The Committee on Finance reported through Senator Cutillo of the 15th District, Chairman of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING ALLOCATION OF FUNDS OF THE CONSTITUENT UNITS OF THE STATE SYSTEM OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10-328 of the 1969
2 supplement to the general statutes is repealed and
3 the following is substituted in lieu thereof: The
4 governing board of each constituent unit
5 biennially shall prepare its budget requests in
6 the form required by sections 4-77 and 4-78 and
7 such additional information concerning its budget
8 requests in such form as the commission may
9 require and submit such requests and information
10 to the commission so that said commission can
11 prepare an itemized proposed budget in accordance
12 with sections 4-77 and 4-78 and submit it to the
13 director of the budget. Said commission shall
14 also prepare for the governor and the general
15 assembly a report of the budget requests of the
16 constituent units and the proposals of the
17 commission for an improved coordinated program of
18 higher education in the state. The governing
19 board of each of the constituent units, within the
20 limits of its appropriation, and [notwithstanding
21 the provisions of any general statute,] WITH THE
22 PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE FINANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE,

23 may determine the allocation of funds for
24 operation and maintenance of the programs and
25 activities authorized for that unit [, except as
26 provided in sections 10-38c, 10-108a and 10-109b
27 and subsection (a) of section 10-324]. Any such
28 governing board may accept, on behalf of the
29 state, any gifts of real property, money, or other
30 personal property donated to the constituent unit
31 for which it is responsible for the purpose of
32 maintaining and administering such unit, and such
33 governing board shall direct the application,
34 distribution or disbursement of such money or
35 other donated property, or the income therefrom,
36 for any purpose connected with such unit
37 consistent with the conditions, if any, upon which
38 the gift was created, provided the state treasurer
39 shall hold on behalf of said board any such gift
40 of money or income therefrom.

41 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1,

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

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Section 1. Section 10-328 of the 1969 supplement to the
general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in
lieu thereof: The governing board of each constituent unit
biennially shall prepare its budget requests in the form required
by sections 4-77 and 4-78 and such additional information con-
cerning its budget requests in such form as the commission may
require and submit such requests and information to the
commission so that said commission can prepare an itemized
proposed budget in accordance with sections 4-77 and 4-78 and
submit it to the director of the budget. Said commission shall
also prepare for the governor and the general assembly a report
of the budget requests of the constituent units and the proposals
of the commission for an improved coordinated program of higher
education in the state. The governing board of each of the
constituent units, within the limits of its appropriation, and
[notwithstanding the provisions of any general statute,] WITH THE
PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE FINANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE, may determine
the allocation of funds for operation and maintenance of the
programs and activities authorized for that unit [, except as
provided in sections 10-38c, 10-108a and 10-109b and subsection
(a) of section 10-324]. Any such governing board may accept, on
behalf of the state, any gifts of real property, money, or other

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personal property donated to the constituent unit for which it is 42
responsible for the purpose of maintaining and administering such 43
unit, and such governing board shall direct the application, 44
distribution or disbursement of such money or other donated 45
property, or the income therefrom, for any purpose connected with 46
such unit consistent with the conditions, if any, upon which the 47
gift was created, provided the state treasurer shall hold on 48
behalf of said board any such gift of money or income therefrom. 49

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971. 50
