AN ACT CONCERNING EVIDENCE IN DRUG CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Assembly convened:

Any person who possesses or has under his control any  
quantity of a controlled drug which according to a schedule to be  
issued by the commissioner of health is too great for personal  
consumption shall be considered prima facie in possession or  
control of such drug with the intent to sell.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide that possession of an excessive  
amount of controlled drugs shall be prima facie evidence of  
intent to sell.
