Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in

Section 9-52 of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof: The registrars of voters in each municipality [may] SHALL hold [additional discretionary] AN enrolment [sessions] SESSION for the purpose of making an enrolment of the electors who are entitled to vote in any primary or caucus in such municipality at [such other times as all such registrars in such municipality deem necessary; but] EACH SESSION OF THE BOARD FOR ADMISSION OF ELECTORS, EXCEPT THAT no such session shall be held on the day when a caucus or primary is held or during the twenty-one days preceding a primary or caucus.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide that at each session of the board for the admission of electors there be an enrolment session, except on a day when a caucus or primary is held or during the twenty-one days preceding a primary or a caucus, and to eliminate discretionary enrolment sessions.
