AN ACT VALIDATING ACTS OF THE BOARD OF FINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

All acts of the board of finance of the town of Plymouth, preliminary to the adoption of a budget for the fiscal year 1971-1972, otherwise valid except that said budget was not published in a local newspaper prior to the annual town meeting but subsequent to a public hearing, are validated.
