AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR FILING BIENNIAL REPORTS OF THE NORWALK TOWN UNION OF THE KING S DAUGHTERS AND SONS, INCORPORATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 The time within which The Norwalk Town Union of the King's Daughters and Sons, Incorporated, of Norwalk, Connecticut, may be reinstated as a nonstock corporation by the secretary of the state is extended to September 1, 1971, and all acts of said corporation and all its corporate rights and all acts of its officers and directors, which would have been valid if it had not failed to file its biennial reports within the time limited by law, are validated provided said corporation shall file an application for reinstatement and comply with the provisions of section 33-497 of the general statutes not later than September 1, 1971.
