AN ACT REINSTATING THE CORPORATE EXISTENCE OF DAVIS ACOUSTICAL CO., INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened: 1 The time within which the Davis Acoustical 2 Co., Inc. may be reinstated as a corporation is 3 extended to February 1, 1972, and all acts of said 4 corporation and all its corporate rights and all 5 acts of its officers and directors, which would 6 have been valid had it not failed to file its 7 annual reports within the time limited by law are 8 validated, provided said corporation shall file an 9 application for reinstatement and comply with the 10 provisions of section 33-388 of the general 11 statutes not later than February 1, 1972.
