AN ACT VALIDATING LATE APPLICATIONS FOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION GRANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 The state board of education and any  
2 divisions thereof shall not withhold the payment  
3 of any funds on the state grants for school  
4 construction or additions relative to John  
5 Winthrop School and Florence E. Blackham School in  
6 the city of Bridgeport on account of late  
7 appreciation for the payment of such funds.
