AN ACT ENCOURAGING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Banking Commissioner, the
2 Labor Commissioner, the Commissioner of Economic and Community
3 Development and the Connecticut Development Authority shall jointly
4 establish a state-wide economic development plan.

5 (b) Not later than January 1, 2007, said commissioners and said
6 authority shall submit a report of their findings and recommendations
7 to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
8 cognizance of matters relating to banks, labor and commerce, in
9 accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
