AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CHILD DAY CARE CENTERS IN MUNICIPAL HOUSING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Each municipal low and moderate rental housing project existing on the effective date of this act shall have established therein in existing facilities child day care centers which are adequate and suitable for the care of children of working mothers residing in such projects. Such centers shall be staffed and maintained by nonworking mothers residing in such projects at a ratio of one mother for not more than four children.

Sec. 2. The sum of _____ dollars is appropriated to the department of community affairs for the purposes of this act.
