AN ACT CONCERNING ADDITIONAL STATE PAYMENTS FOR EDUCATION BASED ON GROWTH OF THE SCHOOL ENROLMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. In addition to the amounts specified in section 10-262 of the 1969 supplement to the general statutes, each town or school district maintaining schools according to law shall be paid by the comptroller, upon certification by the secretary of the state board of education, an amount equal to twenty dollars multiplied by the number by which the average daily membership for the school year prior to the payment of the grant exceeds the average daily membership for the school year ten years prior to the payment of the grant.

Sec. 2. The sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1973, to carry out the provisions of this act.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
