AN ACT CONCERNING CAMP VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 14-44 of the 2006 supplement to
the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
thereof (*Effective from passage*):

4 (a) (1) No person shall operate a commercial motor vehicle used for 5 passenger transportation on any public highway of this state until he has obtained a commercial driver's license with a passenger 6 endorsement from the commissioner, except a nonresident who holds 7 8 such license with such endorsement issued by another state. (2) No 9 person shall operate a school bus until he has obtained a commercial 10 driver's license with a school bus endorsement, except that a person 11 who holds such a license without such endorsements may operate a 12 school bus without passengers for the purpose of road testing or 13 moving the vehicle. (3) No person shall operate a student transportation vehicle, as defined in section 14-212, as amended, 14 15 activity vehicle, [camp vehicle,] taxicab, motor vehicle in livery service, motor bus or service bus until he has obtained an operator's license 16 17 the appropriate bearing an endorsement of type from the
