AN ACT PARTICIPATION IN DISORDERS AT INSTITUTIONS FOR HIGHER LEARNING OR TRADE OR VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS. 15

CONNECTICUT STATE LIBRARY LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE SECTION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened: 17 18

Section 1. Any person enrolled in any constituent unit of the state system of higher education or at any trade or vocational-technical school who participates in any riot or other disorder or otherwise obstructs the orderly administration of any unit or trade or vocational-technical school shall, after hearing by the administrative head of such unit or school to determine such participation, and upon such administrative head being satisfied upon evidence placed before him that such person did participate in such riot, disorder or obstruction, be immediately dismissed for the balance of the semester with loss of credits, by such administrative head and such dismissal shall be effective notwithstanding any appeal under section 2 of this act which may be pending as a result of the actions of such administrative head. Any person dismissed under the provisions of this section shall be reinstated only after such person appears before a review board with his parent or guardian. Such board shall be headed by an administrative officer other than the one who ordered dismissal of such person. If any person after reinstatement again violates the provisions of this section, he shall be permanently expelled from such unit. 19 20 21 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36 37 38

Sec. 2. Any person aggrieved by any action under section 1 of this act may appeal to the state commission of higher 39 40

education which may reinstate such person if it finds that the 41
 dismissal of such person was not justified on the weight of the 42
 evidence.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect from its passage. 43
