AN ACT CONCERNING STATE GRANTS FOR EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 10-262 of the 1969 supplement to the
general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in
lieu thereof: During each school year each town or school
district maintaining schools according to law during the
preceding school year shall be paid by the comptroller, upon the
certification of the secretary of the state board of education,
two hundred TWENTY dollars per pupil in average daily membership.

Sec. 2. The sum of two hundred ninety-seven million, eight
hundred eighty dollars is appropriated for the biennium ending
June 30, 1973, to carry out the purposes of this act.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To increase the average daily membership
grant for education by twenty dollars per pupil.
