Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in	16

Subsection (a) of section 10-151 of the 1969 supplement to	18
the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted	19
in lieu thereof: Any board of education may authorize the	21
superintendent or supervising agent to employ teachers. Any	22
superintendent or supervising agent not authorized to employ	
teachers shall submit to the board of education nominations for	23
teachers for each of the schools in the town or towns in his	24
jurisdiction and, from the persons so nominated, teachers may be	25
employed. Such board shall accept or reject such nominations	26
within one month from their submission. Any such board of	28
education may request the superintendent or supervising agent to	29
submit multiple nominations of qualified candidates, if more than	30

prior to [March] JUNE first in one school year that such contract	44
will not be renewed for the following year, provided, upon the

may, upon written request filed with the board of education
