AN ACT CONCERNING ADVERTISING IN ELECTION CAMPAIGNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Assembly convened:

(a) No person shall solicit in behalf of the candidacy of
another or himself or in behalf of any question being submitted
at the election through the use of advertising prior to September
fifteenth of any election year. Such advertising shall include,
but not be limited to, bill boards, posters, bumper stickers,
television, radio, newspapers, mailings, campaign buttons and any
other campaign materials. (b) Any person who violates any
provision of this act shall be fined not more than one thousand
dollars or imprisoned not more than two years or both.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To prohibit advertising in election
campaigns prior to September fifteenth of any election year.
