AN ACT CONCERNMENT

TO CLARIFY THE RIGHT OF A NEW VOTER TO IMMEDIATE PARTY ENROLMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To clarify and harmonize sections 9-56, 9-57, 9-19b and 9-20 of the 1969 supplement to the general statutes so that any person applying to the town clerk or either registrar of voters for admission as an elector under section 9-19b may apply for, and be entitled to, immediate enrolment on the list of the political party of his preference at any time subsequent to the filing of his application to said clerk or registrar but prior to the session of the board for admission of electors next following said filing.
