AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATION IN THE USE OF VOTING MACHINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. The state board of education, in cooperation with the secretary of the state, shall prepare for use in high schools a sample course of study in the operation of voting machines in use in elections held in this state which shall be available for use in the schools required to teach such course, together with supplementary materials for such use. Such course shall be taught to all pupils enrolled in the senior year in all public high schools and private high schools whose property is exempt from taxation.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide that a course in the operation of voting machines be given to all pupils in the senior year of high school.
