AN ACT INCREASING THE APPROPRIATION FOR SOILS MAPPING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:


The sum of seventy-five thousand dollars is appropriated to the department of agriculture and natural resources for the purposes of number 361 of the special acts of 1965. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 4-88 and 4-90 of the general statutes and section 4-89 of the 1969 supplement thereto, said appropriation shall remain available to the department of agriculture and natural resources until June 30, 1974.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: To provide funds to carry on the soil survey program in the state of Connecticut for the period up to June 30, 1974.
