AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE PROPERTIES REVIEW BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- Section 1. Subsection (f) of section 4b-3 of the general statutes is 1
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective
- 3 October 1, 2006):
- (f) The State Properties Review Board shall review real estate (1) 4
- 5 sales, leases and subleases proposed by the
- 6 Commissioner of Public Works, (2) the acquisition, other than by
- 7 condemnation, or the sale or lease of any property by the
- 8 Commissioner of Transportation under subdivision (12) of section 13b-
- 9 4, subject to section 4b-23, as amended, and subsection (h) of section
- 10 13a-73, [and] (3) review, for approval or disapproval, any contract for a
- project described in subsection (h) of section 4b-91, as amended, and 11
- 12 (4) acquisitions using state funds from any source, including bond
- 13 funds. Such review shall consider all aspects of the proposed actions,
- 14 including feasibility and method of acquisition and the prudence of the
- 15 business method proposed. The board shall also cooperate with and
- 16 advise and assist the Commissioner of Public Works and the

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- 17 Commissioner of Transportation in carrying out their duties. The
- 18 board shall have access to all information, files and records, including
- 19 financial records, of the Commissioner of Public Works and the
- 20 Commissioner of Transportation, and shall, when necessary, be
- 21 entitled to the use of personnel employed by said commissioners. The
- 22 board shall approve or disapprove any acquisition of development
- 23 rights of agricultural land by the Commissioner of Agriculture under
- 24 section 22-26cc, as amended.
