## AN ACT CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN AID FOR VOCATIONAL-AGRICULTURAL SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-65 of the general statutes is
repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July* 1, 2006):

4 (a) Each local or regional school district operating a vocational 5 agriculture center approved by the State Board of Education for 6 program, educational need, location and area to be served shall be 7 eligible for the following grants: (1) In accordance with the provisions of chapter 173, through progress payments in accordance with the 8 9 provisions of section 10-287i, ninety-five per cent of the net eligible 10 costs of constructing, acquiring, renovating and equipping approved 11 facilities to be used for such vocational agriculture center, for the 12 expansion or improvement of existing facilities or for the replacement 13 or improvement of equipment therein, and (2) subject to the provisions 14 of section 10-65b, in an amount equal to [seven] two thousand five 15 hundred dollars per student for every secondary school student who 16 was enrolled in such center on October first of the previous year.
