AN ACT CONCERNING MOUNT FRISSELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2006*) The sum of ten thousand dollars is
- 2 appropriated to the Department of Environmental Protection, from the
- 3 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, for a marker to
- 4 be placed on the slope of Connecticut's highest point, Mount Frissell.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
