In Lynn Walworth Co., Wis., on the 28th ult., of Paralysis, Mrs. Catherine Weaver, aged 76 years. The deceased was among the first who, from the State of New York, settled this part of the West, and founded a Presbyterian church in West Hebron, Ill., of which she was a consistent and active member until the last of her earthly existence. While in its infancy, for the want of a place for public worship, she offered her barn, which was gladly accepted and used for a season. Afterwards when difficulties arose and prevented its meeting in a school-house that had been erected in the neighborhood, she then offered her chamber, which was used with great joy to Zion until a parsonage was erected in which a room was fitted where the people of God could assemble and offer up their devotions to the Triune God. In that room on the day following her death, her funeral was attended by a large concourse of weeping friends who felt indeed a "mother in Israel had fallen." May her mantle fall upon those who survive.
