The funeral of William Winant Thomas, the well-known Wall Street broker, and senior Warden of St. John's Church, took place at 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon. The Right Rev. Dr. Scarborough, Bishop of New-Jersey, officiated, and was assisted by the Rev. Dr. Glazebrook, of St. John's, the Rev. Dr. McAllister, of Trinity; the Rev. Dr. Sleeper, of Grace Church, and the Rev. H. H. Oberley, of Christ Church. The burial was at Evergreen Cemetery.

WILLIAM W. THOMAS, of Elizabeth, in the Diocese of New Jersey, who died at his home May 5th, was unceasing in his benefactions for the extension of the truth of the Gospel, which was dear to his heart. He early recognized the claims of the Church to a share of all that he received, and from the time that he was a clerk upon a salary of \$800 he gave not less than a tenth of his income every year in charity. Many thousands of dollars first and last went from him to aid the missionary work of the Church.

Such devoted friends of missions as both of these who have so recently gone their reward are worthy to be held up as examples, and it does not commend them the less to say that they found their chief pleasure in doing good, and that they regarded it not only as a duty, but also as a privilege.

May the generation of such benefactors of the Church rapidly increase and the joy which they experienced be multiplied.
