## HARTFORD LAND RECORDS

Vol. 2 1709 - 1715

Deed from John Wells of Hartford, Clothier, to Thomas Welles, of Hartford, "for a Valluable Consideration to me already secured", conveying a certain parcel of meadow land in Hartford lying in the great pasture in the South Meadow containing three acres, etc. etc.

Dated at Hartford, July 21, 1714

Sons of Gov. T.W.?

An Agreement of Partition between Thomas Wells and John Wells, Coheirs of Thomas Wells, deceased, of lands belonging to the estate of said Thomas Wells, deceased. Dated, July 21, 1714

Vol. 4 1721 - 1728

Warrantee deed from John Wells of Wethersfield, Clothier, Consideration £150 "Currant Money" conveying to John Curtice of Wethersfield, 16 acres, more or less, of land in Hartford, sometimes known by the name of Oxpasture.

Dated at Wethersfield, March 14, 1724

John Welles, son of Thomas<sup>3</sup> and Mary Blackleach Welles, born Dec.16,1693, is supposed, according to Goodwin (Genealogical Notes, p.256) to have gone to Wethersfield.

We do know that Mary Curtis of Wethersfield born July 5, 1696 married John Welles

Now it is clear that there was no John Welles born about that time in the line of John Welles eldest son of Gov. Thomas Welles.

He married at Wethersfield Dec.30,1715, Mary Curtis.
